Your Planting Planner

YOU CAN PERSONALIZE THIS SIMPLE SPRING PLANTING CALENDAR SO YOU KNOW EXACTLY WHEN TO PLANT YOUR GARDEN CROPS.

First, ask your county extension office (find yours at csrees.usda.gov/Extension) for the average date of the last frost in your area. Fill in the date: ______. In the right-hand column of this table, write in the planting date for each crop, based on the specified number of weeks before or after the last frost date.
